- · Abstracts can only be submitted in English;
- Submitted abstracts should be an original work and do not infringe copyrights, or intellectual properties;
- Only **online submissions** through the congress website will be accepted. <u>Click Here.</u>;
- Abstracts will be published as submitted by the submitter author. It is the author's
 responsibility to submit a correct abstract. Any errors in spelling, grammar or
 scientific fact in the abstract will be reproduced as typed by the author. Authors' list
 will be published exactly as submitted;
- Please ensure that all authors, particularly, the 1st author and presenting author are identified correctly;
- The following subdivisions of your abstract are MANDATORY: Title, Introduction, Purpose, Methods, Results and Conclusions;
- The abstract must not contain identification of the authors or institutions in the text;
- The registration of the presenting author must be concluded **until January 15, 2018**. After that date the abstracts will be withdrawn from the scientific program;
- Oral presentations will have 6 minutes allotted time for presentation (plus 2 minutes for discussion)
- Posters will be expose electronically. E-posters will not be discussed.
